WHAT IS A UNITREAT?

Weekend retreats for Uniteens providing an opportunity to grow spiritually, socialize, & build new meaningful friendships. Activities include large & small groups, Funshops, team building, ropes course, crafts, free-time, music, sports, singing, meditation, dancing, carnival, prayer, fun.

WHO CAN ATTEND?

Central Region Uniteens and their adult leaders/chaperones. (Eligible adult leaders/chaperones must have a Criminal Background Check on file at the church).

Regional Age Requirement: Uniteens must be at least 11 years old, but not more than 14 years old AND in at least the 6th grade but not more than the 8th grade on the 1st day of the Unitreat. No exceptions.

Regional Attendance Requirement: Active participation is defined as attended at least 6 Uniteen Sunday lessons in the 3 months preceding registration. Uniteen participate Depending on what time of the year your church has graduation into the next program - does not affect the incoming 6th graders eligibility to attend if they are typical UNITY YFM participants during the school year. In the past, many questions come up about this - please speak to me directly if you have a question on eligibility. The purpose of this guideline is to ensure the youth are grounded in UNITY teachings prior to attending an event where we dive deeper into our philosophy and that is all we focus on. Any exceptions must be approved by the Regional Consultant in charge.

All participants must be able to honor heart agreements, function in a group setting and MUST attend the entire weekend from check-in thru Closing Ceremony. Youth with special challenges requiring close, personal adult supervision should be accompanied by a parent or familiar adult who will not be responsible for the rest of the group.

WHERE WILL THE UNITREAT BE HELD?

The 2010 Unitreat will be held at Cross Point Camp, Kingston, OK. (NOTE: not all activities available for large groups.) (Please contact your Uniteen Leader for details. All registration applications must be submitted together with the church group to the South Central Region Uniteen Ministry. The camp does not accept registration materials and cannot answer questions about this event.)

WHAT SHOULD UNITEENS BRING?

- FLASHLIGHT!!!
- Sleeping bag (or sheets & blanket) and pillow
- Changes of clothes for each day. **Include hat, jacket & rain gear.** Plan to dress in layers since the weather may be unpredictable. We will have indoor **and** outdoor activities. **Closed shoes.**
- Personal care items
- Refillable water bottle
- Frisbees, baseballs, books, games, journal, etc. for free time
- Money for love offering on Sunday & for meals while traveling.
- Bath towel, wash cloth & shower shoes
- Toiletries bag (toothpaste & brush, hair brush, soap, shampoo, dental floss, mouthwash, **deodorant**, etc.) SEE note next column.

DO NOT BRING: (This applies to both Adults & Teens).

- Electronics such as radios, including clock radios, electronic games, tape decks, etc. are **not permitted.**
- Cell phones, walkie-talkies & beepers used for travel must remain OFF and locked in the car throughout the event.
- CD/ mp3 players may be brought **at your own risk** and will be allowed for use only at **free time and at bedtime WITH HEADPHONES**, as long as it does not disturb anyone.
- Video cameras are **NOT** permitted without **PRIOR** approval of the regional consultant.
- Skateboards and / or roller shoes.
- Overly fragrant shampoo, hairspray – it will draw bugs to you.
