- Meal Grace** – Plan and present a meal grace during the Unitreat.
- Joy Songs** – lead the Unitreat participants in approved joy songs (2 fast/1 slow).
- Set Tables** – set tables for a meal, setting out plates, flatware, cups, etc.
- Snacks for Dance** – bring snacks or drinks for the Saturday Evening Celebration.
- Secret Prayer Pal Table** – Bring craft items for the prayer pal table and help to maintain it's orderliness throughout the weekend. You will also need to help pack up materials on Saturday evening. The region will supply glue, scissors, tape, and some stickers.
- Tattoo Booth** – Staff the tattoo booth during the dance. You will share this responsibility with one or more other groups so you will be free to enjoy the Saturday Evening Celebration.
- Bring and a Staff Carnival Game** – Bring an INDOOR, carnival type activity and staff it during the Saturday Evening Celebration. Group will choose the activity, bringing and setting up all necessary materials and staffing the booth. Uniteen group donations and the Region will supply prizes. You may choose to have it open during all or part of the Saturday Evening Celebration. Your group members will take turns staffing the booth.
- Staff a Region Supplied Carnival Game** – Staff a carnival type activity during the Saturday Evening Celebration. Group will set up all necessary materials and staff the booth. Region will supply the game and the prizes. You may choose to have it open during all or part of the Saturday Evening Celebration. Your group members will take turns staffing the booth.
- Host Skits** – Host the Spirit Group skits on Saturday evening. Introduce each group and keep time.
- Check-In** – Arrive early and help with check-in, welcoming of participants, information and cabin assignments. This opportunity is open to a smaller size group who has attended previous retreats and is able to **arrive by 3:00 p.m. on Friday** to assist as needed.
